The online calendar for all scientific events in Grenoble

I/ CONTEXT

Grenoble scientific richness is revealed everyday with the visits of high-level international scientists, invited to collaborate with one or several of the numerous laboratories and large-scale European instruments operating in Grenoble.

Every week, high-quality events are organized in Grenoble: seminars given by these high-ranking international speakers, workshops organised by Grenoble-based scientific teams or talks intended for the general public. The communication of these events is achieved through various (more or less interconnected) channels, and it happens frequently that researchers receive an event announcement repeatedly - or worse: that they do not receive it at all.

Thanks to its bulletins "38 de Physique" and "38 de Biologie et Chimie", the 'French Society of Physics' (later called 'SFP'), has brought for several years an important support for the communication of the events announcements. With the support of the Nanosciences Foundation, the SFP has decided to develop its current action and launch the "38 de Sciences", which gathers all the bulletins thanks to:

- An on-line calendar on which appear all the event announcements, past and upcoming:

- From September 2012, a newsletter is to be sent out every Friday summarising all the events of the following week. Any researcher may register to this newsletter from the website:

Since they will be available immediately after their publication on the on-line calendar, even the events lately communicated to the "38 de Sciences" secretariat will have more chances to catch the attention of the website visitors.38

With this reliable and professional events calendar, Grenoble acquires a new tool showcasing its scientific dynamism - easily accessible to everyone, and particularly to international researchers visiting us for short or long stays.

We also hope the creation of this agenda will help Organising Committees to choose the date of their event, in accordance with the other seminars and workshops already scheduled within the same period.

II/ HOW DOES IT WORK?

Similarly to the bulletins distributed so far by the SFP, events in Physics (in blue) will be set apart from events in Biology/Chemistry (in green) and other scientific fields (i.e computing, mathematics, technologies... in black). Events related to both Physics and Biology/Chemistry will appear distinctively in turquoise.



Consequently, one can select from the right hand side of the website the list of events related to a particular field only.

Other keywords are associated to each event, in order to get in a glance:

- · which organisation or laboratory is organising it
- if it's a seminar, a PhD defense, a symposium, etc...
- if it belongs to a series of events (of repeated frequency)
- in which geographical area the event occurs, and how to access it

Each keyword may be used as a filter: for example, if one clicks on the name of a laboratory, the list of all the events it has organised (and published in the "38 de Sciences") will appear.

One may also choose to visualise only the events taking place on a given geographical site.

NB: "38 de Sciences" excludes no laboratory nor scientific field. New keywords may be created in order to represent all participating laboratories and series of events.

For now, only the 'Physics' and 'Biology/Chemistry' fields are made distinctive, but others may be identified in the future, if a large number of events related to a particular discipline are posted on the "38 de Sciences".

Thanks to the digital panel, one can quickly visualise if an event is scheduled for a given date. If a short events or a multi days-event is planned at a specific date, its relevant day will turn red. One may also visualise all the scheduled dates for a month, using the little arrows displayed on each side of the month's tag.



Finally, the search bar allows to list all the events (past and upcoming) containing a specific word, or a particular name in its full description.





JOBS SECTION: DIRECTIONS OF USE

The JOBS section of the 38 de Sciences website was developed to make the research of internships, PhD, postdocs and jobs in the Grenoble area easier.

One can find three main sectors for research and training in Grenoble: the "Giant" campus – located on the Polygone Scientifique, the « health » campus located in La Tronche and the "Domaine Universitaire" to be found in Saint-Martin-d'Hères.
